

WARNING: CARPET CLEANER

Any piece of equipment can be dangerous if not operated properly. **YOU** are responsible for the safe operation of this equipment. Caution: When rolling this unit into your home the wheels can pick up dirt and grease. Always carefully wipe the wheels off before rolling unit onto your carpet.

Operation:

After filling solution tank, turn off vacuum and pump switches, connect power cord to grounded outlet and turn preheat switch to on. When the red light goes out, move switch from preheat to clean, then turn vacuum and pump switches to the on position. **Note: vacuum will not turn on when unit is in the preheat setting.**

IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

1. Do not use any solvents or flammable chemicals with this machine.
2. Do not use around explosives or flammable vapors.
3. Do not allow water or foam in waste tank to enter vacuum. Float ball is not activated by foam. Damage will result.
4. Do not plug the cord into an ungrounded adapter or remove ground pin from plug.
5. Do not store at freezing temperature with water in the system.
6. Do not fill with dirty solution.
7. Do not dry vacuum with this machine.
8. Do not run the pump dry.
9. Do not leave unused solution or recovered waste solution in this machine when done.
10. Do not pull the machine by the hoses or cord.
11. Always use a clean bucket to fill the solution tank.
12. Always fill the tank with hot tap water (**140 degrees f max**) **4 GALLONS**
13. Always affix clear dome lid to the machine vacuum tank opening and secure tightly for proper operation.
14. Always disconnect electrical power before draining waste tank.
